Deliberation across deeply divided societies

The talk gives deliberation a dynamic dimension in looking not only at overall levels of deliberation but also at how its level goes up and down in particular group discussions. This concept of Deliberative Transformative Moments is applied to deeply divided societies, where deliberation is most needed but also most difficult to work. The cases are discussions between ex-guerrillas and ex-paramilitaries in Colombia, Serbs and Bosnjaks in Srebrenica, and police officers and locals in Brazilian favelas. Participants addressed the question how more peace can be attained in their countries. The talk makes a linkage between theory and practice of deliberation.
