



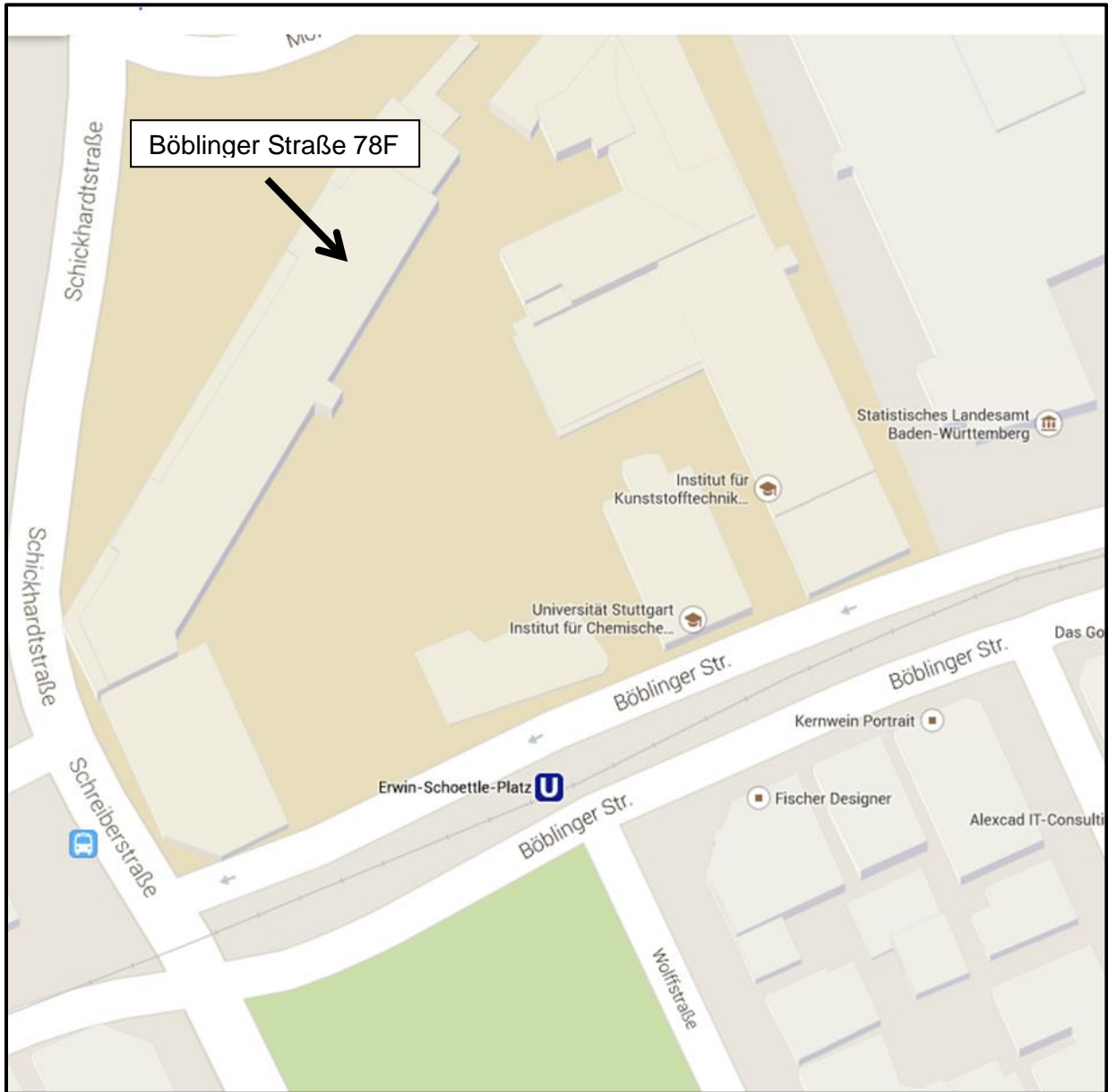

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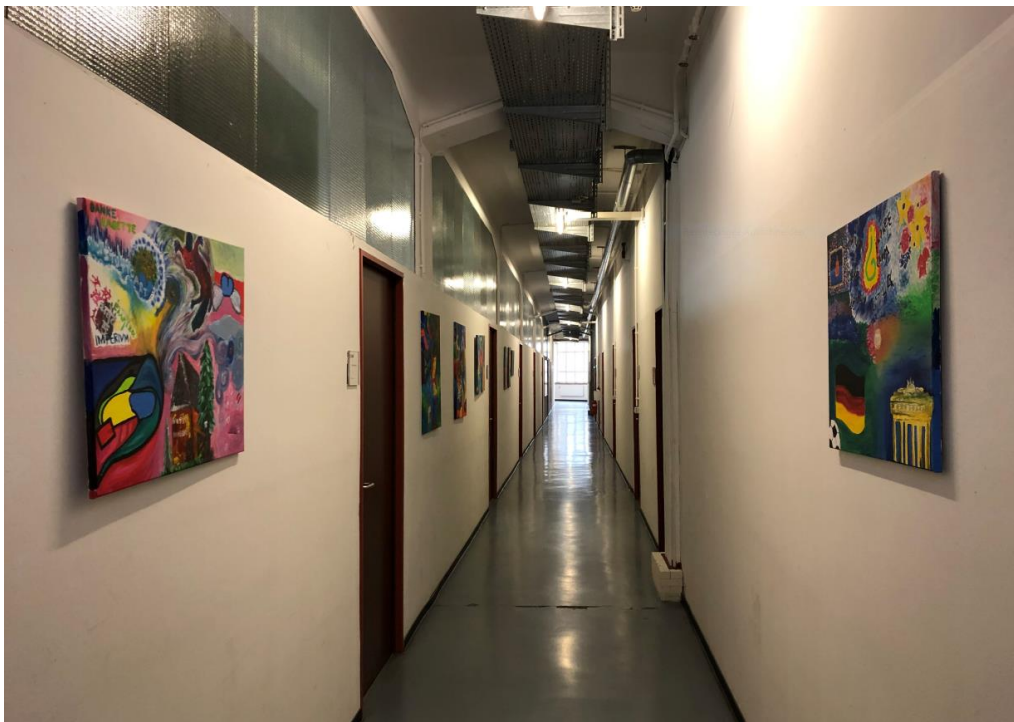

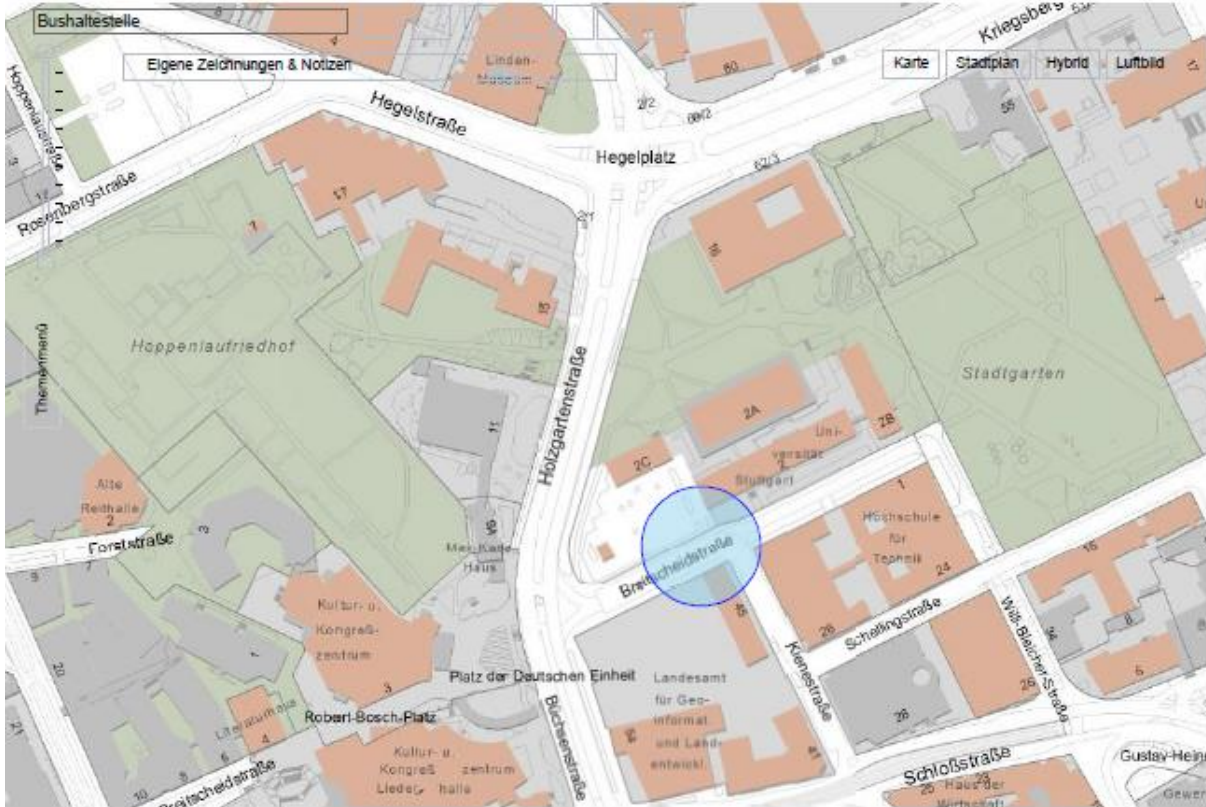

Our suggestion for today: Dip into the past with Stuttgart's Seilbahn (cable railway)

Stuttgart has two rarities in its public transport. The so-called "Stadtseilbahn" in Heslach is a historical cable railway and transports passengers from "Südheimer Platz" to "Waldfriedhof" since 1929. From "Waldfriedhof" you can do the hiking path "Blaustrümpflerweg" which brings you to the U-Bahn stop "Marienplatz".

From there on you can change to the other rarity, which is called "Zacke". The "Zacke" runs between "Marienplatz" and "Degerloch". The views, both trams offer, are spectacular!
