



## Declaration

of the absence of suspicion of an infection with the coronavirus.

I hereby confirm to the best of my knowledge and belief that I

- am not experiencing any typical symptoms of infection with the corona virus, including but not limited to a loss of smell or taste, fever, cough or sore throat
- have not tested positive for coronavirus within the previous 14 days
- am not under an officially ordered quarantine, and
- have not had contact with a person shown to be infected with the coronavirus within the last 14 days.

I am aware that according to § 7 of the regulation of the state government on infection-protective measures against the spread of the virus SARS-Cov-2 (Corona Regulation), a ban on admission to the university and a ban on participation in university events applies to any individual who has been in contact with a person infected with the corona virus within the last 14 days, has had contact with infected persons, or shows any symptoms of coronavirus infection. A violation of the ban on admission and participation constitutes an administrative offence under § 19 No. 5 CoronaVO, which may be punished by a fine.

Furthermore, I am aware that the violation of an officially ordered quarantine in accordance with §§ 75 paragraph 1 number 1, 30 paragraph 1 of the Infection Protection Act is punishable by imprisonment of up to two years or by a fine.

- The data is collected in accordance with §§ 6 and 14 of the Corona Guidelines from June 23, 2020.

- After expiry of the retention period (four weeks) the self-declaration will be destroyed in accordance with data protection regulations.
- It must be ensured that unauthorized third parties do not obtain knowledge of the self-declaration.
- The contact data mentioned above will not be collected and stored if and to the extent that the University of Stuttgart already has the data mentioned.
