



Information about infection prevention measures at the University of Stuttgart during the corona pandemic

The University of Stuttgart has introduced a number of special measures on university premises, to ensure the smooth operation of university processes, and to reduce the health risks related to the spread of the corona virus (SARS-CoV-2).

Before accessing university buildings, please make sure you visit the abovementioned link and that you also read the current SARS-CoV-2 hygiene concept and the University of Stuttgart's Corona Guidelines.

Please be **particularly** aware of the following:

Visitors are prohibited from accessing university buildings, participating in teaching events, examinations, or further events and activities at the University of Stuttgart if they

1. currently have or have had contact with an infected person, if less than 14 days have passed since the last contact with the infected person, or
2. are exhibiting the typical symptoms associated with the corona virus, namely an inhibited sense of taste or smell, fever, a cough or sore throat

By entering university property, or participating in or visiting events, courses or other activities organized by the University of Stuttgart, you declare that the abovementioned points do not apply to you. The University of Stuttgart also requires that, in certain cases, you submit a declaration form stating that the points listed above do not apply to you. If you are of the opinion that complying with the **access and participation ban** is unreasonable in your case, please contact the relevant official named in the University of Stuttgart's SARS-CoV-2 hygiene concept, or the relevant office or official otherwise named by the university of Stuttgart.

In all university buildings, a **distance of at least 1.5 meters** to other people must be maintained at all times. For more information please see the University of Stuttgart's SARS-CoV-2 hygiene concept.

The university will provide all visitors, users and those participating in any teaching events, examinations, or activities at the University of Stuttgart with **hand disinfectant**, and it is expected that you use this. Liquid soap and paper towels will also be provided for washing your hands in the university's sanitary facilities.

The **hygiene rules** detailed in the University of Stuttgart's SARS-CoV-2 hygiene concept also apply.
