regarding the rules for access to buildings and participation in events at the University of Stuttgart

Ban on entry and participation

Under § 14 S. 2 in connection with § 7 of the Coronavirus directive (CoronaVO), there is a ban on entry to buildings and a ban on participation in events at the University of Stuttgart for persons

- who are or have in the past 14 days been in contact with a person infected with Coronavirus, or
- who have typical symptoms of a Coronavirus infection, namely loss of taste and smell, fever, a cough or a sore throat.

Any breach of the ban on entry and participation is an offence under § 19 no. 5 CoronaVO and offenders may be fined.

Quarantine

Any breach of a quarantine officially mandated due to a positive Coronavirus tests shall be punished with up to two years imprisonment under §§ 75 paragraph 1 no. 1, 30 paragraph 1 Infektionsschutzgesetz (IfSG - infection prevention act).

Safekeeping and destruction:

This form will be stored safely by the institution collecting the contact data. This storage must be in line with data protection law (e.g. no unauthorised access to third parties). After four weeks from the time of data collection, the contact data form must be destroyed in line with data protection law.

Collection of contact data

The data are collected on the basis of the state of Baden-Württemberg directive on measures to protect against infection and spread of the virus SARS-Cov-2 (Corona-Verordnung - CoronaVO). The University of Stuttgart is obliged to collect and store your contact data for the purpose of providing information to health authorities or police in accordance with §§ 16, 25 IfSG.

The record of your data will be destroyed after four weeks in accordance with data protection law.
