Scholarship Program "Bridge Builder" for Refugee Students from Ukraine

Did you flee from Ukraine to Germany? Do you want to help shape the reconstruction of Ukraine after your studies? Apply now to receive a scholarship of 931€ (Bachelor/Master students) or 1200€ (doctoral students) per month until 31.12.2024.

The scholarship requires enrolment and active studies at the University of Stuttgart. Requirements for applying:

- Enrolment (or admission) at the University of Stuttgart or a letter confirming supervision by a professor of the University of Stuttgart
- Ukrainian citizenship or equal status*
- The residence permit for temporary protection according to § 24 of the Residence Act
- Very good grades or outstanding academic achievements

*Who can apply?

- Ukrainian nationals who had their main place of residence in Ukraine until February 24, 2022 or have been in Germany as exchange students since the winter semester 2021/22 and did not return because of the war and are now aiming for a degree in Germany
- Third-country nationals or stateless persons enjoying international protection in Ukraine and their family members if they were in Ukraine before February 24, 2022
- Third-country nationals who resided in Ukraine on a permanent basis before February 24, 2022 and cannot safely return to their country of origin.

Application documents:

- CV
- your residence permit according to § 24 of the Residence Act
- a recommendation letter issued by a professor of the University of Stuttgart or a university in Ukraine
- Certificate of enrollment (or admission letter) of the University of Stuttgart or a letter of agreement from a professor at the University of Stuttgart to be your supervisor.
- Essay (max. 2 pages) in which you describe how do you expect to contribute to the reconstruction of Ukraine?
